## Local builder gears up for charity – The Ride To Conquer Cancer

**S**panning one weekend and over 200 kilometres, the Dell'Elce family will be riding for a good cause – The Ride To Conquer Cancer. For Domenic Dell'Elce, his brother Robert and their father Frank, it's a cause that hits close to home.

At the age of 19, Domenic was diagnosed with cancer. As a cancer survivor and the honorary chairman of The Ride To Conquer Cancer, Domenic and thousands of other riders will be joining in the fight against this heartbreaking epidemic.

“When I say ‘heartbreaking,’ here’s what I mean,” says Domenic. “According to the National Cancer Institute of Canada, over 153,000 new cases of cancer and 70,400 deaths from cancer were estimated to occur in 2006. Men outnumber women for new cases by five per cent, and mortality by 11 per cent. That’s why I’m riding – to do something big about cancer.”

The Ride To Conquer Cancer takes place from June 20 to 22, and will take riders from Toronto to Niagara Falls. Participants will include everyone from first-timers to international cyclist Steve Bauer, as well as countless volunteers, and of course, supporters.

While the Dell'Elces have agreed to raise at least \$2,500, their team, “Team Life” has far exceeded this original goal. They’ve already raised more than \$80,000 to date – a number that’s still growing. All proceeds from the two-day cycling event will benefit The Princess Margaret Foundation, one of the world’s top-five cancer institutions devoted to treatment, innovative research, and education programs.
